

**TRANSFER GUIDE for CARL ALBERT STATE COLLEGE AA in Criminal Justice graduates to COLUMBIA COLLEGE of Missouri's Bachelor of Arts in Criminal Justice Administration**

**I. PURPOSE**

The purpose of the guide is to establish a seamless education plan for students completing the AA in Criminal Justice (at CASC) and transferring to the BA Criminal Justice Administration program at Columbia College of Missouri. All Columbia College courses are available online. **Only grades of "C" or better will be accepted in transfer by Columbia College.** Student must enroll in the Associate to Bachelor's (A2B) Program for this plan. **NOTE:** Due to possible Columbia College catalog updates, always consult with your Columbia College Associate to Bachelors (A2B) advisor before making final course selections.
