

CASC Concert Choir Scholarship

The scholarship is a \$250 cash award, renewable for four semesters and a total of \$1000.

The scholarship is based on performance and participation in the CASC Concert Choir. The scholarship recipient's progress will be monitored throughout the year, and a formal review will be held at the end of each semester. The minimum requirements for scholarship renewal are as follows:

1. Enrollment in a one-credit hour course of Concert Choir each semester.
2. Participation in assigned ensemble pending a mandatory placement audition each semester.
3. Demonstration of sincere effort, strong work ethic and attendance.
4. Maintain at least a 2.5 overall grade point average per semester.
5. Enrolling in and completing at least 12 credit hours per semester.

Students who meet these standards will have their scholarship renewed each semester for up to four semesters. Failure to meet standards during any semester could result in forfeiture of scholarship for subsequent semesters.
