Current CASC students may enroll using VIKECONNECT or with an Academic Advisor, and should examine the online DEGREE AUDIT available in VIKECONNECT to verify degree completion. Final degree checks are done in the Office of Admissions, and students can confirm graduation status. Students should have a final degree check done before pre-enrollment.

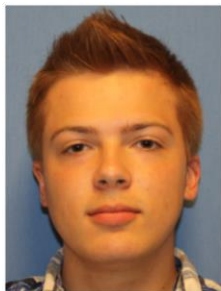
